Brad Henry is currently serving his second four-year term as governor of Oklahoma. He was re-elected in 2006 by one of the largest margins in state history. Governor Henry was born in Shawnee. In 1988, he was awarded his law degree from the University of Oklahoma College of Law, where he served as managing editor of the Law Review.

Brad Henry served ten years in the Oklahoma State Senate before his election as governor. As a result, the governor has enjoyed great success in passing major planks of his legislative agenda and moving the state forward.
